FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

The **Department of Agriculture (AGR)** assumes they would not be fiscally impacted by this proposal.

In response to identical legislation from last session, the **Greene County Commission** assumes they would incur costs of approximately \$98,000 the first year and approximately \$76,000 in the subsequent years if a leash law were enacted.

Oversight assumes this proposal is permissive and would allow officials of Greene County to enact a leash law. There would be no costs unless an ordinance would be passed by the county's governing body.

FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

DESCRIPTION

This bill allows Greene County to enact an ordinance for any unincorporated area that is zoned residential that requires persons owning or responsible for the control of a dog to restrain the dog from running at large.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
