This proposal adds to the definition of the "interested party" entitled to law enforcement accident or incident reports before the information is available to the public to include street departments of the jurisdictions where the accidents or incidents that are the subjects of the reports take place.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program, and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
