**FISCAL ANALYSIS**

ASSUMPTION

**Secretary of State (SOS)** officials assume no state fiscal impact.

Officials of the **St. Louis County Board of Election Commissioners** stated this proposal would have no fiscal impact.

Officials of the **Kansas City Election Board** stated that there would be some cost in reprinting envelopes and applications, however, officials assume this could be accomplished with current appropriations. Officials assume negligible impact.

The **Cass County Clerk** stated there would be no fiscal impact to their county.

In response to identical legislation from last session (HB 625) the **Taney County Clerk** assumed no fiscal impact.
