FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

DESCRIPTION

This proposal requires custodial orders to permit all parents access to the child's health insurance provider.

Insurance providers are to provide coverage information regarding a child to both parents if the parents are separated or divorced. If the coverage is terminated, the insurer is to notify the non-custodial parent within 10 days.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
