FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

DESCRIPTION

This proposal would change the requirements for state employees to continue their health care benefits upon leaving state employment. Current law requires a state employee who is entitled to an annuity, retirement benefit, or disability benefit (including benefits for the employee's spouse or unemancipated children) to have been covered for the 2 years prior to the date of death or disability of the employee. This proposal would reduce that coverage period requirement from 2 years to 6 months.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
