DESCRIPTION

Currently, test procedures, specifications, tolerances, and technical requirements for tank wagons are governed by the National Bureau of Standards, Handbook 44 and supplements thereto. This proposal permits exceptions for procedures, specifications, tolerances, and requirements specifically modified, amended, or rejected by a regulation issued by the Director of the Department of Agriculture.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
