FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

DESCRIPTION

This bill changes the qualifications for Kansas City police officers. Under current law, a Kansas City police officer must be a citizen and resident of Kansas City for at least one year. This bill requires them to be a citizen and resident of the county in which Kansas City is located for at least one year.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
