FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials of the **Department of Health** and the **Department of Social Services** stated that the proposal would have not direct fiscal or administrative effect on their agencies.

Advertisement costs for the proposal would be \$4,380 per newspaper column inch for three printings of the text of the proposal, the introduction, title, fiscal note summary, and affidavit. The proposal would be on the ballot for the November 2000 general election.

FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

DESCRIPTION

This proposal would specify that equality under the law in Missouri not be denied or abridged on account of gender. It would also specify that the proposal not be construed to require the state to fund abortions or recognize same sex unions or marriages.

The General Assembly could enforce provisions of this proposal by legislation.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space. This proposal would not affect Total State Revenue.
