FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

DESCRIPTION

Under current law, no cause of action exists against fire protection entities for equipment they donate to other entities if the State Fire Marshal approves the equipment. These immunities only apply to actions directly related to this equipment. This bill requires any motor vehicle that is donated to pass a safety inspection by the Missouri State Highway Patrol. Receiving agencies must also demonstrate to the Fire Marshal that any equipment received works properly. Donor agencies must inform the receiving agency of any defect they know about in the equipment.

DESCRIPTION

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
