FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials with the **Department of Transportation** indicates the legislation requires the installation of two signs naming a portion of I-29 in Buchanan County the "Sergeant Robert Kimberling Memorial Highway." MoDOT assumes the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their agency, if they were to receive contributions from civic organizations or individual donors to pay the one-time cost for the two signs at each end of the designated portion of I-29 at an approximate cost of \$2,504.
