FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

DESCRIPTION

This proposal would make any person guilty of a class A misdemeanor for transferring fetal parts without disclosing information about the transfer to the Department of Health, including any valuable consideration received. Disclosure of the contents of the transfer would also be made to a common carrier or delivery service. The proposal would make exceptions for transfers of fetal tissue samples for medical testing by a licensed pathologist or for burial and cremation with no valuable consideration provided.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
