ASSUMPTION

FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

This bill requires persons seeking elective public offices for which posting of a bond is required to prove they will be able to obtain the bond prior to being allowed to file for the office.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
