FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

DESCRIPTION

Under current law, nursing home directors are elected within districts. This bill allows the directors to be elected at-large or within districts at the initial election. Following the initial election, the Circuit Court may choose to elect the directors at-large.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
