ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Revenue** (DOR) assume their drivers license system vendor would charge \$3,000 for custom programming to implement this change in drivers license procedure. **Oversight** assumes this cost is minimal and can be absorbed from existing DOR resources.

Officials from the **Office of State Courts Administrator** and the **Department of Transportation** assume no fiscal impact to their organizations.
